The meeting began with a prayer followed by the reading of the minutes of the meeting held on April 19th 2017. The minutes were proposed by Mrs. Suvarna Gauns and seconded by Ms. Vida Sequeira.

Ms. E. Fernandes and Dr. D. Antão who had attended a meeting on solid Waste Management organized by the CCP informed the members said that they had made a suggestion to the Corporation of the City of Panjim (CCP) to let Nirmala Institute of Education collaborate with them in working on Solid Waste Management with children of the secondary schools across Goa. The CCP had welcomed this idea and would be sending a letter in this regard to the Institute shortly. The Faculty could then meet to plan and discuss the future plan of action. Mr. Blaise Costabir congratulated the IQAC Co-ordinator Dr. Delia Antão for this initiative.

The Principal, Dr. Martins said that the following Committees need to be constituted for the various academic and co-curricular activities. He stressed the need to document all activities whether on Campus or outside for the purpose of the forthcoming NAAC visit in 2019. Efforts should also be made to publish them in local dailies.

Mrs. Ximena Fonseca said that the formation of these committees could be discussed during the Faculty meeting and assigned the work to the respective faculty members.

Dr. Martins informed the members that some amount of the UGC grant was still left over hence asked for suggestions as to how it could be utilized. Ms Fernandes suggested that we could have a State level Intercollegiate One Act Play competition as people of Goa are fond of drama.

Dr. Delia Antão reminded the members that according to the suggestions made by NAAC committee during their visitation, the Institute needed to conduct a PTA meeting. Mrs. Suvarna Gauns said that this does not apply to us as our students are not so young and from our previous experiences we have seen that the parents of our students refused to attend such meetings. They complained that their children no longer depend on them for educational choices made in the college and some of their children are also already married. To this Dr. Antão said that there was no could always discontinue the practice in future.



Ms. Eutemia Fernandes said that since Atmashodha Counselling Cell has been doing some commendable work in career guidance and counseling, they could organize some workshops for our internship schools as they are of great help to our Institute by allowing our trainees to complete their internship programme. The minutes of the previous meeting held on March15, 2018 were presented by Dr. Delia Antao, the Officiating Principal.

Deliberations:

Item 1:

Ms. Eutemia Fernandes said that the following initiatives were undertaken in Geography to enhance teaching and learning:

- a) Geography Day was organized by the students of Geography.
- b) Use of ICT was demonstrated through Computer Aided lessons.
- c) CD's containing Geography materials were prepared and the same are used by school teachers.
- d) Students are encouraged to correlate Geography with other subjects.
- e) Feedback was obtained from schools in relation to the performance of the teacher trainees at their respective schools.

Dr. Ubaldina Noronha asked what mechanism is used to get feedback from schools. Dr. Paes clarified by saying that at the end of internship, schools send-in feedback to the college.

Dr. Denzil Martins said that lessons in Science contain an element of creative and critical thinking. Critical thinking being necessary to enable students to decipher facts from information thereby knowing what is right and what is wrong.

Ms. Ximena Fonseca said that emphasis is laid on embedding cooperative learning, use of jigsaw puzzles and enriching lessons through PowerPoint and video.

Ms. Suvarna Gauns said that she encourages the use of drama in teaching. Street plays were also used during the teaching-learning process.

Dr. Russell D'Souza said that he looks at the environment in which learning occurs so that theory can be translated into practice thereby maintaining a balance between what the schools need and what the trainees need to know. He also said that he is inclined towards creating/developing learning materials using technology.

Dr. Rita Paes said that the teacher trainees need to have clarity of concepts while teaching. This means that students need to conceptualise and challenge themselves to comprehend concepts across subjects.

Dr. Pissurlekar said that Education Colleges, the school administration and the other agencies related to Education in Goa must work hand-in-hand to support schools to be change friendly.

Items 2 and 3:

Suggestions

The following were the suggestions:

- a) Ms. Eutemia Fernandes said that while presenting ICT lessons, modules should be designed for students by considering the textbook content.
- b) Dr. Noronha said that the college website can upload the lessons/modules.
- c) Dr. Russell D'souza said that Goa University has the SWAYAM/MOOCS platform and the college needs to design some lessons and put them up on the MOOCS platform

d) Dr. Denzil Martins said that the Department of Education should send the circulars to the schools as well as the teacher training colleges so that they can be kept in the loop, but it is not happening.

e) Dr. Rita Paes said that the school teachers are reluctant to participate in the workshops conducted by NIE as these workshops are not considered a part of the 21 days in-service

programmes that they should attend.

f) Dr. Denzil Martins said that the Best Speaker Award can also be instituted.

g) Dr. Ubaldina Noronha added the following suggestions:

1. Conduct a workshop by Arvind Gupta for the teachers.

2. Set-up various cells/clubs/associations on campus.

3. Invite inspirational figures to change the attitude of the teachers.

4. Build a strong Alumni Association. Organise a talk every month for the students by the alumni.

5. Newsletter should be worked upon. It can be quarterly and digital. It should also be sent to alumni.

 Conduct a workshop on Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) for faculty and students. The following Resource Faculty could be invited;

a. Dr. Saba D'Silva

- Adv. Menezes, a Corporate Lawyer
- c. Ms. Ranjana Ferrao, a Copyright Expert

d. Ms. Shalini Menezes

- 7. Annual Calendar should be discussed during the Head of Departments' Meeting/Staff Meeting and should be included in the annual diary.
- 8. Previous NAAC/NCTE reports should be studied and improvements should be done accordingly.
- 9. The Best Reader Award can be instituted

10. Install a Public Address System.

- 11. The IQAC should have its own e-mail Id. All events/documentation should be available with the IQAC.
- 12. Document photographs and attendance of students who go on field trips.

13. Students could be encouraged to contribute the Caution Deposit to the college.

- h) Dr. Pissurlekar said that some short-term courses should be conducted by the college. He also said that the IQAC meetings should be conducted 3 times in a year. The first IQAC meeting at the start of the year should communicate expectations to the teachers, the second IQAC meeting to review the progress and the third to check work done.
- i) Dr. Pissurlekar also suggested that internal marks can be given for Library work. He also opined that the college should look at the NIFR ranking.

Item 4:

- There is a possibility of starting the B.A. B.Ed. / M.Ed. B.Ed.
- For B.A. B.Ed. NOC from DHE & NCTE for a grant-in-aid programme should be obtained.
- Structure needs to be taken from University website

Item 5:

The members opined that administrative staff could be exposed to new trends of managing an office.

Items 6 and 8:

The members unanimously said that Faculty Improvement Programme (FIP) is necessary and could be conducted on a variety of themes. Some members also said that NAAC/ICSSR/DST provides grants for organizing National Conferences. ICG could be considered as a venue as they provide accommodation to the participants.

Item 7:

One outstation trip per department for Final Year Students and one Local trip for First Year students should be conducted. Paper presentation can be combined with the study trip.

Item 8:

Teachers must be encouraged to write research papers based on projects that their students do. Teachers could also collaborate with students to write research papers. Broadway Publishers may be contacted for publishing the papers.
