Action Taken Report

Feedback was presented before the Faculty meeting, and the following actions were taken to improve the functioning of the Institution:

1. Student teachers were trained in communication skills and basics of the English language.
2. Videos related to classroom management were shown to students during theory lectures, and discussions were held on strategies to control and manage student behaviour.
3. Visual Arts lectures were reduced compared to previous lectures on the timetable.
4. Peers were also asked to provide oral feedback on lessons they observed, and written feedback was maintained in an observation book for detailed feedback based on the observed lessons.
5. Sessions on Financial Literacy and Banking were conducted based on student suggestions.
6. Field trips and visits were planned and carried out for the students.
7. Students were involved in respective events organized by the State based on circulars received from the Department of Higher Education with relevant directions.
8. Sessions on Mental Health and well-being were conducted.
9. Sessions on Nutrition and Health were organized for the trainees.
10. At the beginning of the academic year, sessions were organized on digital tools, technology usage, etc., for the trainees.

11. A camp conducted for students involved engaging them in community-related activities and helping them connect with society.
12. Courses on Inclusive Education, learning Disabilities etc. were conducted by ADIRA.
13. A STEM education course on Robotics was also conducted for trainees.
14. In the future, some programs will be planned for teaching foreign languages, musical instruments, and other computer-based IT courses.
15. For PGDGC Music and Art therapy were included as activities
16. Library facilities were improved.
17. The course is in the process of upgradation and restructuring is planned to make it more practical oriented.
